The Quest for a Solution

In a gathering of his devoted companions, Prophet Muhammad acknowledged the complexity of a pressing issue. The atmosphere was charged with speculation and contemplation as the companions sought a resolution to a problem they were facing. When the Muslims came to Madinah, they were able to offer Salah behind Prophet Muhammad in congregation. However, they were finding it hard to identify the time for Salah. Certain visual cues were given to them to work out the times for prayers, but a little error in judgement could mean that they would miss praying behind the beloved, Prophet Muhammad. This was not bearable for the devotees to miss the blessing of being close to the light that illuminated their lives and brought them out of the darkness of ignorance.



Seeking answers

The companions kept thinking about a solution and began brainstorming about the possible options. "Let us use a bell like the bell of the Christians", some companions proposed. Others said, "let us use the ram's horn, called shofar that the Jews use." Another group of companions suggested that a flag should be raised when the time for Salah would come, and when people would see it they will call one another to come for prayer. Each suggestion, however, was met with concerns about mirroring practices from other faiths and not being able to properly address the issue at hand. Being a universal religion, Islam proposes those solutions which are not bound by time, place and people. Such a solution was searched in this matter too.



A Unique Solution

Amidst the discussions, Umar (RA) offered a unique idea. He proposed appointing a single person to personally call each individual to Salah. This suggestion was met with a sense of possibility, despite the challenges of reaching every Muslim in the growing city of Madinah.



An Inspiring Dream

Abd-Allah ibn Zayd (RA), one of the companions of the beloved Prophet Muhammad # left the gathering of the companions while being immersed in thoughts about how this issue could be resolved. That night, he saw an amazing dream. Narrating his dream to Prophet Muhammad , he said: I saw a man carrying a bell in his hand. I said, "O slave of Allah, will you sell that bell?" he said, "What will you do with it?" I said, "We will call the people to Salah with it." He said, "Shall I not show you something better than that?" I said, "Yes." He said, "Say, Allah is most Great, Allah is most Great, Allah is most Great, Allah is most Great. I bear witness that there is no god but Allah, I bear witness that there is no god but Allah. I bear witness that Muhammad sis the Messenger of Allah, I bear witness that Muhammad significant is the Messenger of Allah. Come to Salah, come to Salah. Come to success, come to success. Allah is most Great, Allah is most Great. There is no god but Allah." Then he went a short distance away from me, and then looked at me again and taught me the words of Igamah which is said just before the prayer stands.

Divine Approval

Upon hearing Abd-Allah's (RA) dream, Prophet Muhammad

confirmed the truth of the dream as his heart was given comfort in it by Allah SWT. He instructed Abd-Allah (RA) to teach these words to Bilal (RA), known for his beautiful and resonant voice. Bilal (RA) learned the Adhan from Abd-Allah (RA) and his voice received the blessing of chanting the glory of Allah SWT and His messenger to call people to Salah.



Salah is better than sleep!

In the call for the dawn Salah, Fajr, Bilal (RA) added a phrase: "As-salatu khairun min an-naum" (Salah is better than sleep), recited twice. Prophet Muhammad approved this addition. In this manner, Bilal's (RA) voice used to wake people up from sleep. On hearing the call from him, they used to leave their warm beds in winter and comfortable sleeps during summer in order to gather in the house of Allah. Men as well as women used to come for Fajr salah at the masjid. The women were, however, given the concession that they could also pray at home, as required.



Lessons learnt

One can learn many lessons from this journey of establishing the adhan. Let's review some key ones.

System of decision-making:

Decision-making in Islam is linked to consultation (called 'shura'). Every voice is heard and respected. The leader examines all suggestions on merit and selects what he finds to be the best. The preference is given to the most meritorious suggestion; it does not matter whether that suggestion came from a junior person or the senior like Umar Ibn Al-Khattab.



Do not imitate the non-Muslims in their religious matters:

From the manner of assessing different options in the story of establishing Adhan, we understand that Muslims are prohibited to imitate disbelievers in their religious matters. We should not adopt their religious practices even if we see the society at large indulged in them. We have our own beautiful faith which provides guidance about every walk of life. The more we read about it, the more we fall in love with it. Let's celebrate its brilliance and thank Allah SWT for blessing us with it and the guidance of His messenger ...



Other lessons


- This story also shows us the concern of the companions and our beloved Prophet Muhammad for the Salah. Salah was the coolness of their eyes so they wished to be there in the masjid as the time for Salah came and hence they were looking for a call to be made for Salah. We should also strive to make Salah the focal point of our lives.
- The status is Islam is not linked to how much wealth one has, the color of one's skin, or one's family. The nobility is due to the character. That is why Bilal (RA) who once used to be a slave beaten around in the streets of Makkah became the 'Syed' (the noble leader) of the Muslims. Everyone, rich or poor, used to turn to Masjid upon his call.
- The wording of Adhan sets our priorities straight. It tells us that Allah SWT is bigger than whatever we are engaged in work, sleep, video games, mobiles, cricket, footy and everything else. Nothing should stop us from availing the wonderful opportunity to connect with our Creator through Salah.

Let us aim to make Allah SWT, our beloved Messenger ﷺ, and our beautiful Deen our number 1 priority. Let's aim to let our life, not our words, tell the story of our extreme love! May Allah SWT guide us all and engulf in His limitlesss mercy.


